Dear Parent/Carers,

I am sure the most recent government announcement will have brought with it some concerns for you and your family. I want to assure you that we will continue to do our utmost to support you and your children. The following information has been taken from the most updated government guidance:

'Schools continue to remain open for all children and young people as they have since the start of the autumn term for the duration of the national restrictions.

Being at school is vital for children's education and for their wellbeing. Time spent out of school is detrimental for children's cognitive and academic development, particularly for disadvantaged children. This impact can affect both current levels of education, and children's future ability to learn. It continues to be our aim that all pupils, in all year groups, remain in school full-time. The risk to children themselves of becoming severely ill from coronavirus (COVID-19) is very low and there are negative health impacts of being out of school. For the vast majority of children, the benefits of being back in the classroom far outweigh the low risk from coronavirus (COVID-19) and schools can take action to reduce risks still further.'

Please keep yourselves and your families safe by adhering to the new lock down measures. We understand for many, these are testing times but the restrictions are to support us all. Please also note that due to the serious nature of the lockdown restrictions if we are made aware of any families not adhering to the new lockdown measures, we will be reporting this to the appropriate authorities.



YEAR 6 – PARENT COLLECTION OF CHILDREN

Dear Year 6 parents, this year, your child will sit their end of Key Stage 2 assessment and having already missed a significant amount of time from school, we are working hard to provide children with the best support possible. This often involves utilising every minute and every hour in the day. Therefore, often children are still working hard in lessons until 3pm (Please remember that the requested collection time for Year 6 is 3.00pm - 3.15pm). Therefore, any parent arriving at school earlier than 3pm to pick up a child in Year 6 will be asked to wait on the playground until your child is ready. This is so that your child is not missing any more important learning time than absolutely necessary.

FOOD BANK VOUCHERS

We recognise that the new lockdown restrictions will cause greater financial strain to many of you. This is not an easy time, especially given that already shops are running out of essential supplies. As a school we are able to provide emergency food vouchers for the Great Barr Food Bank, so if you find yourself urgently needing food supplies, please contact the school and we will arrange some vouchers for you.
