Staffing Update

From the week beginning 1st March, there will be some staff changes at St. Mark's. We will sadly be saying goodbye to some members of our St. Mark's community. While staff adjust to their new roles, we will be holding one live learning session the first week back and this will be a short wellbeing session with teachers and children currently in school. It will last about 15 minutes and it is a chance for children to see their peers and share some news about their half term holiday – perhaps what books they have been reading or activities they have been doing.
