Dear Parents and carers,

It has been lovely to welcome the children back to school this week. We have missed them! In a few weeks' time, after children have settled back into the routine and structure of school life, teachers will be conducting some assessments to ensure gaps in children's learning are identified and addressed rapidly. These assessments will be informal and will be used to support teachers' future planning so we can make the most of every lesson between now and the end of the Summer Term.

Please remember that the school gates now open at 8:35am, the gates no longer open at 8.30am and please note that the gates open at the end of the day at 2.55pm, not 2.45pm. We have a 20minute time slot for children to be dropped off and collected, however, the majority of parents are arriving in the first ten minutes (2.55pm- 3.05pm). As a result, a large crowd of parents are gathering on the playground making social distancing difficult and also difficult for the member of staff on duty to identify all parents promptly to call the children down from the classrooms.

Please appreciate that our aim is to get children out as quickly and as safely as possible, but this is not helped by large crowds of parents gathering on the playground. Please consider the time you arrive to collect your child/ren and how busy this time is so that the following day, you can adjust your timing accordingly. I am going to monitor this for another week as I appreciate that with any new system there are often teething problems, however, if the crowds of parents continue to form, making social distancing difficult, I will allocate specific time slots to classes. Please can we all be sensible and look to see how busy the playground is before we enter it.

Starting week commencing 22nd March 2021 the school will be undertaking some redevelopment work to make the school pathways safer. This will involve the complete resurfacing of our main entrance pathways. Children's wellbeing and safety is our

Avenue green gates only. Year 2 only: drop offs and pickups to school will be through the Kingsdown Avenue green gates only. Year 2 only: drop offs and pickups will be through the car park green gates adjacent to the caretaker's house. Only 1 of the car park gates will be open for pedestrians only. The redevelopment work will also mean that the normal access to the main school office entrance will be unavailable. As a result, for the duration of the redevelopment work, parents / visitors are requested to enter through the school car park gate adjacent to the caretaker's house. Your co-operation during the redevelopment work to improve our school will be much appreciated. While this work will cause some barriers, we are excited for the changes that will be made to enhance our pathways. The projected timeline for the redevelopment is 1-2 weeks. When completed, the new pathways will ensure the safety of all our children, parents and visitors when entering our school building. We will keep you updated on the progress of the work.
