Dear Parents and carers,

It was wonderful to welcome ALL the children back this month and thank you to all of YOU. Working with you as parents is crucial to the work we do here at St. Mark's. We recognise that your children have had a very turbulent time this past year and I am sure many of you will have seen changes in your child at one point or another. We have given the children this month time to settle back into the routine of school, become accustomed to St. Mark's behaviour and respect expectations, work with others on all areas of the curriculum and take time to socialise and enjoy all the activities, interactions and familiarities of St. Mark's school again. I wish you all a very happy and Holy Easter. Please enjoy the break and the sunshine. Remember, from the 12th April, restrictions will change again but we ALL must remain vigilant. The school will continue to operate in the same way (in a bubble system) and hygiene and distancing will remain a priority. Staff continue to complete lateral flow tests twice weekly. I remind you all that any family suspected of not adhering to the government guidelines will be challenged and possibly reported as we all have a duty to do what is needed to reduce the transmission risk of Covid. We are not out of the woods yet so please remain vigilant!



Research Findings... Food for thought!

International Early Learning Child Well-being Study (IELS) conducted research on reading and found the following:

- By age 5, parents reading to children, helping them read words and sentences, and having back-and-forth conversations is associated with greater development in a range of areas.
- Reading to children at least 5 days a week was associated with greater development in emergent literacy, when compared to those who did this less than once a week.
- Children whose parents helped them to read words and sentences on 3 or more days a week had greater development in both emergent literacy, emergent numeracy, and the self-regulation measures than children whose parents did so less than once a week or never
- Children with more books in the house did better in all areas.
- Parental engagement with schooling was associated with greater development, particularly in social-emotional measures.
